    - The City expects to be eligible to apply for a 2016 application based on expenditure rates of the 2014 grant.
  - b. **Supplemental Activities:** information and schedule:  
Per 2015 NOFA:
    - 3 Supplemental Activities maximum
    - Must be eligible activities and meet a National Objective
    - Supplemental Activities cannot be Public Services or PTAs
    - Activities must be completed within the expenditure period of the grant
