POSITION SUMMARY:

Performs a variety of semi-skilled tasks in the construction, repair, installation, and maintenance of City public works facilities, buildings and grounds and streets.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Exposure to sun and weather, walking on uneven surfaces, bending, kneeling, squatting, twisting, exposure to airborne dust and loud noises; climbing of ladders of up to 12' above ground, driving, working on slippery surfaces, working with toxic substances; occasional lifting of items weighing up to 50 pounds, lifting above shoulders; repetitive hand motion; hear verbal instructions; climb in/out of ditches; climbing flights of stairs; lift and carry pipes; dig ditches; small motor skills. Work in and around raw sewage and wastewater, raw sewage waste fumes and sewer gases. Driving a motor vehicle; receiving oral instructions; reading written instructions.

TYPICAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Removes and replaces road material such as asphalt.
- Excavates and exposes sewer lines and mains.
- Paints crosswalks, curbs, stop and center lines.
- Janitorial tasks, such as collecting trash and emptying trashcans, cleaning restrooms, vacuuming, sweeping and general cleanup work
- Cleans and maintains equipment used in the course of work.
- Performs landscape and maintenance tasks such as pulling and cutting weeds, mowing, trimming, and watering plants.
- Perform other maintenance duties as assigned.

MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT AND TOOLS:

Shovel; string trimmer, rake, paintbrush and roller, paint sprayer, and lawn mower.
