ARTICLE 1 - INVITATION TO BID

- 1.01 Notice Inviting Bids:** Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Fort Bragg ("City"), 416 North Franklin Street, Fort Bragg, California 95437 on or before 2:00 pm PDT, on June 29, 2023 for the following public work:

- 1.02 Project Description:** The project work is generally described as the rehabilitation of pavement of up to eight (8) streets throughout the City, including approximately 3.5 miles of street striping on 7 additional streets, several sections of sidewalk (curb, gutter, and ADA curb ramp) installation, and rehabilitation of the specialty stamped crosswalks in the downtown business district as further described in the bid package. Work shall be completed within a max of 109 working days (base bid within 70 working days, alternative 1 within 24 working days, and alternative 2 for 15 working days) from the date when Contract Time commences to run.
- 1.03 Engineer's Estimate.** The Engineer's Opinion of Probable Costs is approximately \$2,662,410 base bid, or \$3,351,824 with Alternates 1 & 2 included.
- 1.04 Procurement of Bidding Documents:** Bidding Documents contain the full description of the Work. Bidders may examine a complete hard-copy set of the Bidding Documents at the Fort Bragg City Hall, located at 416 North Franklin Street, Fort Bragg, California 95437. For on-line viewing of current bid postings and Project details, go to <https://city.fortbragg.com>. Bidders may obtain electronic Bidding Documents at no cost by contacting Chantell O'Neal, at (707) 961-2823 Ext.133, or emailing coneal@fortbragg.com on or after May 25, 2023. There will be a \$168.25 non-refundable charge for each printed bid package, electronic copies are distributed at no cost.
- 1.05 Instructions:** Bidders shall refer to Instructions to Bidders for required documents and items to be submitted at the date and time as set forth in Paragraph 1.01 above.
- 1.06 Pre-Bid Meeting and Site Visit:** The City will conduct a **non-mandatory** Pre-Bid Meeting and Site Visit at 2:00 pm on Monday, June 12, 2023 at City Hall, 416 N. Franklin Street, Fort Bragg CA 95437. The Pre-Bid Meeting and Site Visit will last approximately one and a half (1.5) hours.
- 1.07 Bid Preparation Cost:** Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their Bids.
- 1.08 Reservation of Rights:** City specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all Bids, to re-bid, or to waive inconsequential defects in bidding not involving time, price or quality of the work. City may reject any and all Bids and waive any minor irregularities in the Bids.

ARTICLE 2 - LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

- 2.01 Required Contractor's License(s):**
- A. A California class "A" contractor's license is required to bid this contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract.
- 2.02 Required Contractor and Subcontractor Registration**
- A. City shall accept Bids only from Bidders that (along with all Subcontractors listed in Subcontractors List) are currently registered with the Department of Industrial Relations ("DIR") and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5.
- B. Subject to Labor Code Sections 1771.1(c) and (d), any Bid not complying with paragraph 2.01A above shall be returned and not considered; provided that if Bidder is a joint venture (Business & Professions Code Section 7029.1).
- 2.03 Bid Alternates:**

- A. Bid alternates are identified as follows:
Alternate 1: Pine Street & Harold Street, Harold Street & Redwood Avenue, E. Oak Street, S. Harold Street & S. Lincoln Street, Harold Street.
Alternate 2: Azalea Circle, and Penitenti Way.
- B. The determination of lowest bid shall be based upon: Base contract bid plus those alternates specifically identified above as being used for the purpose of determining lowest bid.
- 2.04 [SECTION REMOVED]**
- 2.05 Substitution of Securities:** City will permit the successful bidder to substitute securities for any retention monies withheld to ensure performance of the contract, as set forth in Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention and incorporated herein in full by this reference, in accordance with Public Contract Code Section 22300.
- 2.06 Prevailing Wage Laws:** The successful Bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents. Copies of the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute the Contract, as determined by Director of the State of California Department of Industrial Relations, are on file at the City's Public Works Department, may be obtained from the California Department of Industrial Relations website (<http://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/dprevagedetermination.htm>) and are deemed included in the Bidding Documents. Upon request, City will make available copies to any interested party. Also, the successful Bidder shall post the applicable prevailing wage rates at the Site.
- 2.07 Prevailing Wage Monitoring:** This Project is subject to prevailing wage compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.
